DIRECTIVE 2011/65/EU OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL (RoHS)

of 8th June 2011

on the restriction of the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment (RoHS)

According to the above Directive (and the extension of the delegated Regulation 2015/863/EU) the following substances are prohibited or restricted in use in electrical and electronic equipment.

- Lead (0,1%)
- Mercury (0,1%)
- Butylbenzylphthalat (BBP) (0,1%)
- Diisobutylphthalat (0,1%)
- Cadmium (0,01%)
- Hexavalent Chromium (0,1%)
- Dibutylphthalat (0,01%)
- Polybrominated Biphenyls/PBB (0,1%)
- Polybrominated Diphenylether/PBDE (0,1%)
- Di(2-ethylhexyl) phthalat (DEHP) (0,1%)

We confirm that our standard products do not contain any forbidden materials as mentioned in the above guidelines as of July 1st 2006.

REGULATION (EC) No 1907/2006 OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL (REACH)

of 18 December 2006

concerning the Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemicals (REACH)
